Grower Insurance – QF 207

Moses and Son's Sheep's Back To Store Endorsement Policy

During the period of Insurance:

- Cover commences from the time the sheep enter the sheds for the purpose of shearing and continues within the shearing sheds for a maximum period of 90 days.
- Cover whilst in the shearing shed is restricted to loss or damage to the goods caused by Fire or Theft.
- Cover terminates when the goods are out of the Insured's or their designated carrier's care and control and placed and/or positioned inside the receiver's or other designated warehouse or premises.

Required Insurance Information Checklist

This checklist is designed to assist growers by outlining the information that is required when making an insurance claim for lost or stolen wool. Every effort has been made to make the checklist comprehensive; however on a case by case basis the Insurance Company may request additional information.

Details of Premises

- Owner of premises.
- Name of Premises.
- Specific address of where the bales were lost.
- Description of premises, age, size etc.
- Security of property in detail*.
- How is the shed locked, chain padlock, tumbler lock etc?
- Days and times the shed is attended.

Details of Wool Stolen

- Wool brand name.
- Description of the wool.
- Quantity of wool stolen/bale weights*.
- Value of each bale of wool and how valuation was calculated.
- Date of shearing*
- Proof of wool ownership at time of the loss. Wool Book and/or Classers specification
- Where were the bales destined for, consignee? Is there a tax invoice available?

Details of theft

- Date and time the bales were last seen and by whom.
- How long had the bales been stored in shed prior to the loss?
- Who discovered the loss?
- Where were the bales located in the shed? i.e. distance from pick up/entrance
- Point of the suspect's entry and point of exit.
- Comments on whether one person could have perpetrated this theft.

Photographs required

- Shed
- Point of entry
- Point of exit
- Security
- Where the bales were stored

Documentation

- Classer specification
- Wool Book
- Tally Book
- Tax invoice, if applicable
- Delivery docket, if applicable
- Diary entry from Moses and Son of shearing notification.

* Essential information to ensure the validity of your claim.
