The AWEX EMI closed on 1172c, up 14c at auction sales in Australia this Week. Once again, the offering failed to achieve the early estimate of 41,154 bales, with just 37,289 bales eventually being offered which resulted in 95.6% of the offering cleared to the trade.

The Australian wool market recorded an overall solid increase this week, driven by strong prices in the merino fleece sector.

Merino Fleece On Tuesday in Sydney, a modest Merino fleece auction saw price increases as the sale advanced. The upward trend continued on Wednesday, resulting in notable gains by



the end of the week, with the 18 and 19 μm MPGs rising by 31 and 26 cents, respectively.

Merino Skirtings Stylish Merino skirtings with favourable length and good colour attracted keen demand. Lots carrying cotts struggled for competition.

Crossbreds Crossbred wool had a good week overall. The 28-micron Merino Price Guide (MPG) increased by 6 cents, while other MPGs remained steady. Oddments stayed the same on Tuesday, but crutchings and locks showed an upward trend on Wednesday.

Commentary: Next week's quantity is forecast to rise, due in part to the sellers being encouraged to the market. As all centres no longer move if one centre has a local Public Holiday, newt week is an unusual selling pattern. Sydney and Fremantle will sell on Tuesday/Wednesday while Melbourne will sell Wednesday/Thursday, to accommodate the Melbourne Monday public holiday.
